**Mission Statement:**

**AWARD:** The Royal Canadian Legion No.39, is awarding two annual \$500.00 scholarships.

**PRESENTATION:** These scholarships will be awarded annually on November 11<sup>th</sup>.

**Eligibility:** Shall be available to any post-secondary students, who have graduated from either The Vegreville Composite High School or St. Mary's High School. One scholarship will be awarded to a first year student and the second scholarship will be awarded to a second or third year student currently enrolled in an accredited program in the province of Alberta. Applicant shall be 25 years of age or younger. A student is able to make only one successful application

**SELECTION CRITERIA:** Descendants of a Veteran or a member of the Royal Canadian Legion Branch No.39 will be given first consideration. Legion involvement, community involvement, other extra-curricular and academic achievement will be determining factors.

**PREREQUISITES:** Applicants must have the required prerequisites acceptable to the receiving institution. (Application, essay, letters of reference, proof of registration) Applicants must provide proof of post-secondary registration to the Scholarship Committee prior to deadline.

**REFERENCES:** Applicants are to provide two reference letters pertaining to the four main areas of consideration. (Legion, community involvement, extra-curricular activities and academic achievement)

**DEADLINE:** Applicants **MUST** submit application and all other prerequisites to the school counsellor by **June 1st** of the current school year and then on or before **September 30<sup>th</sup>** application, essay, letters of reference, and proof of registration are to be submitted to the President of the Royal Canadian Legion Branch No.39.
