Background Information

The Right Honourable Don Mazankowski Scholarship was founded in honour of and as a tribute to an outstanding businessman, parliamentarian, cabinet minister, Deputy Prime Minister and friend. Don has earned the respect of Canadians for his distinctive contribution to the Canadian way of life.

This scholarship is designed to encourage students who have attained exceptional academic and citizenship qualities to achieve their educational goals and aspirations. Selection of recipients is based on academic achievement as well as citizenship including leadership, community involvement, and participation in organizations.

In 2008, the University of Alberta took over the administration of these awards.

Eligibility Criteria

- Applicants must be residents of the geographic area defined below for a minimum of two years prior to application deadline.
- The geographic area is defined as the rural municipalities and all cities, towns, villages and First Nations and Métis settlements within the boundaries of:
 - Lamont County
 - Smoky Lake County
 - Beaver County
 - County of Minburn
 - County of Two Hills
 - County of St. Paul
 - · County of Vermilion River
- MD of Wainwright
- Flagstaff County
- MD of Provost
- · Camrose County
- · MD of Bonnyville
- · County of Paintearth

The boundary includes all areas that were at any time part of the Vegreville Federal Constituency.

- The applicant must be enrolled in a program that has a minimum of five months duration at a post-secondary educational institution.
- An applicant may receive this scholarship only once.

Application Procedures

- An official high school transcript must accompany the application. In the case of a student who is beyond their first post-secondary year, applications must be accompanied by a current post-secondary transcript as well as a high school transcript.
- Applicants must submit three letters of reference with their application.
- >> Applications must be in English. This includes reference letters and any other supporting materials.
- The deadline for receipt of fully completed applications, including transcripts and letters of reference, is February 28, 2023. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
